May 27, 1973

137 people responded to God's challenge to form a new church with a mission of reaching and ministering to people in far south Austin. Ground was broken in the fall for the first of four major buildings to come.

August 1974

The year-old congregation moved into the new gymnatorium (now known as the Student Building), complete with chicken wire-covered walls and basketball goals at each end.

May 1979 The Children's Building was built with 22 classrooms

> May 1980 Prayer Chapel was completed

May 1983 Worship Center completed and opened on Bannockburn's 10th Anniversary.

26-room classroom building (Education Center) was completed.

April 2007

The Abington Center Opened its doors, in memory of the church's founding pastor. It was part of the master plan for the church campus since the church's beginning.
