

# Lord, Teach Us To Pray

4-Week Prayer Guide



## WEEK 1: PRAYER FOR A DEEPER LOVE FOR THE LORD AND A DESIRE TO GLORIFY HIM AT BANNOCKBURN

---

- **Pray for a deeper love for the Lord and desire to glorify Him.**

*“Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.”  
Deuteronomy 6:5-6*

- **Pray for unity and love among our church members.**

*“Eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.” Ephesians 4:3*

- **Pray for spiritual growth in the congregation.**

*“So as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.” Colossians 1:10-11*

- **That we would count the cost and be willing to follow Jesus by daily dying to self.**

*“And He summoned the crowd with His disciples, and said to them, ‘If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me.’” Mark 8:34*

- **That we would desire to be obedient to Christ’s commands.**

*“If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.” John 14:15*

*“Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock. Matthew 7:24-25*

## WEEK 2: PRAYER FOR THE OUTREACH AND IMPACT OF BANNOCKBURN

---

- **Pray for the youth and children's ministries.**

*"Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it."  
Proverbs 22:6*

*You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.  
Deuteronomy 6:7*

- **Pray for our families within the church.**

*"And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."  
Joshua 24:15*

- **Pray for our church to hold fast to God's priorities.**

*"But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."  
Matthew 6:33*

*"Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. 3 For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God." Colossians 3:2-3*

- **Pray for our church's passion for the gospel.**

*"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." -  
Matthew 28:19-20*

- **Pray for healing for those in need.**

*"Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord." James 5:14-15*

## WEEK 3: PRAYER WISDOM AND DIRECTION FOR BANNOCKBURN

---

- **Pray for wisdom for our church leaders.**

*"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." James 1:5*

- **Pray for a thoroughly-informed and lived-out biblical worldview.**

*"We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ..." 2 Corinthians 10:5*

- **Pray for spiritual protection over our church.**

*"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil." Ephesians 6:10-11*

- **Pray that our church would have the fear of the LORD, not fear of man.**

*"I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body and after that have no more that they can do. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear the One who, after He has killed, has authority to cast into hell; yes, I tell you, fear Him!" Luke 12:4-5*

- **Pray that our church be on guard against false teaching and that we would keep ourselves in sound doctrine.**

*"See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ." Colossians 2:8*

## WEEK 4: PRAYER FOR THE MISSION OF THE CHURCH

---

- **Pray for salvation and new life!**

*Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6*

- **Pray for those who are far from God to come to know Him.**

*"The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance." 2 Peter 3:9*

- **Pray for humility and servant hearts within the church.**

*"Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others." Philippians 2:3-4*

- **Pray for the youth to stand firm in their faith.**

*"Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity." 1 Timothy 4:12*

- **Pray that our church would love its enemies**

*"You have heard that it was said, 'you shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous..." Matthew 5:43-45*
